February

1. Wednesday: I took stuff down to set up for Plan E Annual Meeting. Bitter cold – had up to 100 [in attendance?]. Made \$5.00 on food. Dr. Patterson was excellent. . . . Took Mrs. De Felice and cream home; then home at 11:00 to pack for Newlin for Philadelphia.

2. Thursday: Took Newlin and red string bag of shoes to Harvard MTA at 8:11. Minus eight degrees – COLD. . . . Home to clean up and wash all dishes after Plan E. Newlin had supper with Linford and walked home from Farm House in moonlight and snow. I had tea with Mrs. Lamm –

3. Friday: Threats of snowstorm. Newlin phoned, and I put the chains on at bedtime – thank goodness.

4. Saturday: Snow all day. Real blizzard. Wicky shoveled! Newlin canceled plane ticket and waited on train too.

5. Sunday: Driveway still snowed in. Wicky and I went to North St. Church. Very nice and neighborly. Finished driveway at about 5:00. Smiths did garage apron and down to the gate, I took sled down to meet Newlin and bag. Sat till 10:20! Zero again.

10. Friday: Shopping! Got Wicky the paper, black sweater (\$9:00), and new driving gloves for me (\$3.00). Nice. Drove to Cambridge for cardboard. Now he is all set for his diesel “poster.”

11. Saturday: Did new Plan E directors cards all a.m. To Elaine Philippi Hyde's funeral in pretty church on Cochituate Road off Route 20.
